On the displayed teacher pay stub are two deductions: **MSMA 125MEDT** – this is the participant’s Medical FSA account. The amount listed under ‘current’ is the per pay amount being contributed. **MSMA 129DEPT** – this is the participant’s Dependent FSA account. The amount listed under ‘current’ is the per pay amount being contributed.

Medical FSA Accounts may also appear on pay stubs as MSMA 125MED. Dependent Care FSA Accounts may also appear on pay stubs as MSMA 125DEP.

You should get a paper or electronic copy of your pay stub each pay period. ***The password to open your electronic paystub is the last 4 digits of your social security number.*** If you cannot find your electronic paystubs, you may contact the payroll specialist to find out what email address they are being sent to: **(207) 871-0555.**
